

# **RULES**

#### **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

- A. Teams will consist of 5 bowlers; you must have 1 senior and 1 female.
- B. All games bowled will be in baker format. Baker format consists of games where all 5 bowlers combine, together bowling towards a one game score. Bowler 1 will bowl frames 1 and 6, bowler 2 will bowl 2 and 7, etc. A Baker game is bowled on 1 lane only.
- C. Each team will bowl 24 Baker game matches to determine qualifying for a single elimination tournament on Sunday. Ties will be broken by the total pin fall.

#### SECURING YOUR TEAM

A. Team sign up will begin on April 1st

#### **ENTERING AVERAGE**

- A. Use 2023/2024 Bowl.com composite average. If no 2023/2024 average, we will go back to the 2 previous years. If no average previous 2 years, we will use current high book average as of March 1<sup>st</sup>,2025 with a minimum of 21 games. (If none of this applies men will enter with a 225 and women will enter will 200)
- B. The team maximum is 1000 average (This is a scratch Tournament)
- PBA Members must use a 235 average as their entering average.

- D. Failure to use the correct average will disqualify a team if the corrected average elevates the team average above the 1000 maximum
- E. Sport League average will not be used
- F. The Tournament Director has the right to re-rate any bowler and has final say on all matters.
- G. \$120.00 per Bowler or \$600.00 per team

#### **SQUAD TIMES**

- A. Saturday June 21<sup>st</sup>,2025 24 games of qualifying. Practice starts at 9:30am (check in at 8:00am)
- B. Sunday June 22<sup>nd</sup>,2025 Practice to start at 9:30am (check in at 8:00am) for a Single Elimination Tourney with 2 game match play

#### LANE MOVEMENT

- Odd lanes will move 1 set left
- B. Even lanes will move 1 set right
- C. After each match from whatever lane, you started on

#### **TEAM LINEUP**

A. Your submitted line up is the line up that will be used for the first 4 game block of qualifying

- B. The 2<sup>nd</sup> block of qualifying your roster will rotate your 1<sup>st</sup> bowler will now be the 2<sup>nd</sup> bowler etc. for the next 3 blocks of 4 games of qualifying so 5 blocks of 4 games (20 games total) and your last 4 games can be whatever you want.
- C. During Sundays Match Play Tournament at the start of each match You can change your roster, but no changes will be made during a match.

#### MATCH PLAY TOURNAMENT

- A. Seeding will be determined by total pins during the qualifying matches. Any ties will be broken by a 1 ball roll off by a chosen team member of your choice until the tie is broken and changing bowlers every frame.
- B. Match Play is first to 2 points, it will consist of 2 Baker games, one game bowled on each lane. Each team win is worth 1 point, pin count does not count. If the match is split the highest seed will choose which lane to bowl a third tie-breaker game. If that third game is a tie, we will have a one frame roll off starting with the first bowler on each team and working through the line up till there is a winner.

#### **TEAM SHOOTOUT**

- A. Team Shootout is included in your entry fee
- B. Saturday after qualifying
- C. The Team Shootout consists of several rounds of "High Ball"

- Each team will send a different bowler for each round. Once all
   team members have bowled you will continue with the same rotation till the Shootout is completed or your team is eliminated.
- E. Each round will consist of 1 ball thrown by a player from each team, the bowler or bowlers that are tied with lowest pin count Will be eliminated, then the teams that are left will send up a Different bowler and we will do it again until there is only 1 person Left
- F. 4 teams will cash in the Shootout
